**“Access 2007 and SharePoint, the Beginning of a Beautiful Friendship”**

### “Emailing your Board of Directors”

The unbridled growth of spam has impacted DAAUG very negatively. Some of your board members are receiving more than 1000 spam emails per day through the DAAUG account. Unfortunately, the ISP we use for email does not provide a filtering service on the email server, so we are forced to deal with the flood of spam on our own computers. Spam can tie up a lot of band width when hundreds of pieces must come to the computer before they can be checked by any filtering software.

Your DAAUG board is working on changing the way you can reliably email us, but that change may not come about for a while. So, in the mean time, I ask all of you to do as we board members do when communicating with each other: *put the word DAAUG in the subject line of any email you send to a board member*. That will pretty much ensure that your message will be noticed. I, for one, have an Outlook

rule set up to delete *all* email that comes in through the DAAUG president account, *except* for those with DAAUG in the subject line. If you tried to contact me this year and did not receive a response, now you know why. It was not personal, just self defense! Resend the email with DAAUG in the subject line and I'll be sure to see it.

I wish spam would just go away. Since it won't, we all have to deal with the issue. I hope the easy workaround I mentioned above makes it easier for you to communicate with your Board of Directors.
